Associate Members who perform services or function in the capacity of a Full Member, i.e., contract or subcontract for the fabrication of structural steel, shall be responsible for the payment of Full Member dues tonnage and the payment of dues in the same manner as a Full Member to the nature and extent of such contracting or subcontracting. The annual dues for Associate Members shall be applied as credit toward the amount of dues owed for tonnage purchased/shipped.
