


STEEL LIBS Super Structural Steell

After the steel cools and gets rolled into different shapes and sizes, it can then be used to construct things like buildings where **people** live and work. A five-story, steel-framed **office building** uses 500 tons of structural steel. **Yowza**, that is a ton of steel! That is equal to 360 shredded cars, 65 tons of recycling from homes and offices, 79 tons of industrial scrap, and 122 **<u>old</u>** appliances. Next time you see a steel building or bridge, imagine all the old steel items that were recycled and used to **make** it. Nearly seven trillion pounds of structural steel are produced in **the United States** every year, which is about <u>**500,000**</u> fully grown African elephants. <u>**Gadzooks**</u>, that is a lot of elephants! The average American uses at least 10 things made of **steel** before they even **leave** the house in the morning. Steel is super!
