AISC Certification has published the annual update to the *Governing Requirements for Certification Programs* (*GRs*). The updates will take effect for all applicants and certified participants on June 15, 2025.

Please refer to the preface of the *GRs* and the *Supplemental Requirements* for a list of changes including new glossary definitions, the addition of multi-site audits to the program, and changes to audit finding terminology.

To maintain your certification, you must ensure your quality management system (QMS) meets the updated *GRs*. Auditors will begin issuing Corrective Action Requests (CARs) for nonconformance with the updated *GRs* on June 15, 2025.

## Why update the GRs?

Our industry is constantly evolving--that's one of the things that keeps steel on the cutting edge! We update the *GRs* each year to provide additional clarity and keep up with the pace of innovation. You can expect similar updates each spring, with changes taking effect in June each year.

As a reminder, the GRs govern the administration of the certification program from application to certificate determination. They should be your go-to reference for compliance with our program and administrative processes.
