Initial Application Fee The fee is in addition to the fees listed in the above chart. This fee only applies to a company's initial application for certification.	\$2,000	
Expedited Application Process Optional for either initial applicant or certified participant's Scope Change. Includes moving to the top of the list for all reviews (certification application and audit evidence reviews) & documentation audit, and conduct a site audit within 60 days of the documentation audit completion.	\$5,000	
Eligibility Review Refund If an applicant does not successfully complete the eligibility review, the applicant's original fee will be refunded minus the "review fee" noted to the right.	\$1,000	
Documentation Audit Refund If an applicant does not successfully complete the documentation audit, the applicant's original fee will be refunded minus the "review fee" noted to the right.	\$2,000	
Certification & Endorsement Scope Change (Optional for participants only) Applicable when a participant requests an additional certification. This will include an Application Review, Documentation Audit, and Onsite Audit.	Contact AISC	
Rescheduled Site Audit Applicable if an auditee requests a date change to their annual, renewal audit. Please see the noted Bulletin 2019-05 for details.	Contact AISC	
Additional Site Audit Applicable when an additional audit is required, for example: determination of CAR implementation, profile/management change, recommendation of an Unannounced Audit, shortened Certification Certificate, etc.	Contact AISC	
Pre-Assessment/Gap Analysis (Optional) The pre-assessment is conducted to assist a non-certified company considering certification in determining the implementation status of their quality management system.	\$3,000
