<b>Expedited Application Process</b> Optional for either applicant or participant's Scope Change. Includes moving to the top of list for all reviews (certification application and audit evidence reviews) & documentation audit, and conduct site audit within 60 days of the documentation audit completion.	\$3,500	
<b>Eligibility Review Fee</b> If applicant does not successfully complete the administrative review, original payment less the "Eligibility Review Fee" is refunded to applicant.	\$1,000	
<b>Documentation Audit Fee</b> If applicant does not successfully complete the documentation audit, original payment less the "Documentation Audit Fee" is refunded to applicant.	\$2,000	
<b>Certification &amp; Endorsement Scope Change (Optional for participants only)</b> Applicable when a participant requests an additional certification. This will include an Application Review, Documentation Audit, and Onsite Audit.	See Chart Above	
<b>Additional Site Audit</b> Applicable when an additional audit is required, for example: determination of CAR implementation, profile/management change, recommendation of an Unannounced Audit, Conditional or shortened Certification Certificate, regional approvals, etc.	Price Stated on Invoice	
<b>Rescheduled Site Audit</b> Applicable if audit is cancelled auditee has been notified of the audit date(s).	\$1,800	
<b>Pre-assessment/Gap Analysis (Optional)</b> The pre-assessment is conducted to assist a company considering AISC Certification in determining the implementation status of their quality management system.	\$2,000	

1) The AISC Certification Program operates on a three-year cycle. A Certification Cycle consists of the following phases: Initial Certification (INIT/RFN) or a Full Certification Renewal (FULL/RF), First Continued Certification Renewal (CCR1/R1), and Second Continued Certification Renewal (CCR2/R2)  
 2) In the *Requirements for AISC Certified Erectors of Structural Steel*, Item #10 states: "Participants must have an active job-site in the United States of America that can be visited to conduct the site audit."
